

“Jenneau Sun Odissey 36i” Bowsprit installation



In this Jenneau Sun Odissey 36i, the bowsprit was installed in a way that the forepeak’s entrance could stay clear. This way, the bowsprit could stay on even during a sailing cruise or when you would like to anchor.

The installation was made thanks to a custom-made ring bracket inserted into the left bow roller.

The back end of the bowsprit was fixed with interposition of a Delrin shim to obtain the desired inclination.

The bowsprit leaves the forepeak and anchor clear for cruising use.
